PHILOSOPHY

Children are apt to get off to a better start in school if they begin with basic skills and attitudes as well as some general knowledge about the world. We have created an educational Petite Elite program based on the needs of children. We offer a developmentally appropriate setting and curriculum to encourage a positive unique learning experience.

A safe, nurturing, structured environment is provided while children learn the readiness skills needed for kindergarten. A balance of teacher directed and child directed activities are provided by degreed teachers, as well as, swimming instructors, music teachers and fitness instructors.

We believe an emphasis on self-esteem is important and accomplished through enthusiasm, positive reinforcement and redirection. Each child learns at their own pace and time spent communicating with parents is key to ensure the goals for their child are accurately defined.

CURRICULUM

The curriculum for the Petite Elite class is based on a kindergarten readiness list with theme based lessons plans each week. The lessons are designed to encourage all stages of development, social, intellectual, physical and emotional growth. Experiences will foster progress with reading and writing readiness, general knowledge about self and world, math and science skills, speaking and listening skills, large and fine motor skills and social skills.
