School will be coming to an end soon and summer will truly be here! Elite Sports Club Mequon will be enjoying its first complete summer with the outdoor pool and Grill open. We are excited to begin our summer programs and events that will provide fun and summer enjoyment for you and your family.

To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all our members and guests, we would like to review some policies with you.

Children

Although our facility is child-friendly, our Ezone and Playroom are ideal places to drop off the children while you work out. Also our extensive list of programs will provide a variety of supervised play options, including our ever-popular Summer Scamp. Children left unsupervised have a tendency to get bored and into trouble. Please remember that you are responsible for your children's activities and behavior while in the club. As a reminder for age appropriate access to areas of the club a family policy sheet is enclosed with this letter.

After experiencing past situations where children have been injured or have caused facility damage, we are certain our policies are beneficial to both the family and other members and guests of the club. Balancing the importance of safety with enjoyment of the facility is our goal.

New

We have listened to your concerns about the policy "under 15 children must have a parent on the premises". To continue to add value to your family membership and assure a safe haven for your children, we are providing a new special drop off policy. Children who will be entering or are currently in middle school and older will now be allowed in the club without a parent on premise. In order to have this privilege the enclosed Code of Conduct form must be signed by both the parent and child. When you will not be able to stay in the club with your child, you and your child will be required to sign in and out. Unsupervised time will be limited to 3 hours. If children are here longer than that, we find they tend to get bored. Please review this Code of Conduct with your child, sign and bring with you the next time you visit the club.

Guests

Elite Sports Club is a private club. To assure safety and exclusivity of membership, all members and guests must enter through the front entry. Members must present their membership card to "scan in" and all guests must register. This procedure allows us to know who is in the club in case of an emergency as well as keep the integrity of your membership privileges. A \$25 fee will be charged to your account for an unregistered guest. As a reminder, our guest policy allows your guest to come to the club 4 times a year but you can bring as many different guests as you would like. At any one visit you are limited to 3 guests. Please call ahead if you would like to bring more guests at one time.

Pools

With the addition of the outdoor pool during the summer, our pool schedules will change slightly. A life guard will be on duty at the outdoor pools during pool hours of operation. Children 7 and under will always need parental supervision. Older children can swim at the outdoor pool without a parent if they are independent swimmers. The indoor pools will be reserved for lessons and lap swimming and will not be lifeguarded. However, we will provide parent supervised swim indoors during certain times. Please refer to the pool schedule at eliteclubs.com before visiting the club to insure your family's optimum enjoyment at the pools.

Club towels will not be allowed at the outdoor pools. We will offer a towel service using a larger beach towel. If you choose not to bring your own beach towel for the outdoor pool, you can purchase a \$25 token to exchange for an Elite beach towel when checking into the club. When you return the towel to the front desk your token is returned to you. This service works very well at our Elite Brookfield club and eliminates the problem of running out of towels.

The summer is our busiest season for families. With everyone's cooperation in adhering to these policies, we can assure that our members of all ages will enjoy the many benefits an Elite Sports Club membership provides.

Junior Drop Off Code of Conduct

As a junior member on a family membership I understand that I will have drop off privileges if I will be attending middle school or high school in the fall. These privileges allow me to be dropped off at Mequon Elite Sports Club without parental supervision. In order to retain these privileges, I understand that I must:

1. Sign in at the front desk.
2. Limit my stay in the club to no more than 3 hours outside club organized programs*.
3. Be respectful to other members, guests and staff.
4. Practice good sportsmanship in all sports and game activities.
5. Not use cell phones in the locker rooms.
6. Practice good behavior when using the locker rooms and café.
Screaming and aggressive behavior will not be tolerated anywhere in the club.
7. Not deface club property or disrupt normal operations of the club.
8. Respect that access to the fitness center requires TNT training. My parents can schedule a session with a trainer.
9. Not use the Cardio Theater and Group Exercise rooms.
10. Respect that the elevator is restricted to service staff, members with disabilities and strollers.
11. Respect other programs in session and do not interrupt.
12. Be aware of the discipline policy stated below.

Discipline Policy

- **First Offense** – Verbal Warning by the staff and parents will be contacted.
- **Second Offense** – Written Warning given by the staff, parents will be required to pick up child from the club.
- **Third Offense** – Drop off privileges suspended for 2 weeks.
